Opportunities will be considered in all newsroom departments. The internship comes with a \$2,500 stipend awarded by AAJA-Chicago in honor of chapter co-founder David Iбата for his dedication in giving a voice to Asian Americans. The Chicago Tribune also will pay the intern \$8.25 an hour for a 40-hour work week.

Eligibility

- Junior, senior, or graduate student
- 2013 student member of AAJA. Membership is open to everyone. Apply at www.aaja.org.
- Candidates must have completed at least one internship at a daily news organization other than their college newspaper

Detail

- 12 week internship
- \$2500 stipend plus wages
- 40 hours a week
- No benefits or paid days off

How to apply

- Complete the application form.
- Submit a resume and the names of at least two professional and one school reference (with titles, phone numbers and email addresses).
- In your cover letter , please specify whether you are seeking a reporting, editing, photography, design or other internship.
- Five to 7 work samples that represent your best work and show your range of experience. Professional clips preferred over classroom work.
- Applications must be postmarked by Feb. 15, 2013.
